

DECK MOUNTING FIXTURES FOR ETXv3 ENCLOSED SPEAKER SYSTEMS






Determine the mounting location of the ETXv3 enclosure. Using the holes in the fixture base as a guide, mark the three hole locations, and carefully drill three 3/16" pilot holes and one 1/2" speaker cable hole.



Route the speaker cable exiting the enclosure through the opening in the other half of the fixture, and guide the tabs into the openings in the fixture until flush.



Remove the 5/16 - 18 x 1-1/4" socket head cap screw and 5/16" lock washer to separate the two fixture halves. Secure the fixture base to the mounting surface using three #14 x 1-1/4" flat head sheet metal screws (included).




Apply Loctite* red thread-locking compound (included) to the two 5/16 - 18 - 1-1/8" machine screws (included), thread them into the fixture while firmly pushing the enclosure and fixture together to ensure no gap, and fully tighten.




Route the speaker cable exiting the enclosure through the hole in the fixture base, and align the two fixture halves together.




Use the supplied butt connectors to connect the red (+) and black (-) speaker cable exiting the ETXv3 enclosure to the speaker cable below the mounting surface. The green and white wires will not be used in this application





Remove adhesive backing and install the JL Audio logo



If a different speaker angle is desired, remove the speaker mounting screws and washers.



Rotate the speaker to the desired angle. Reinstall the speaker and speaker mounting screws and washers. Hand-tighten the screws in a criss-cross pattern.



For best adhesion, it is recommended to clean the inside of the aluminum cap with acetone (not included), prior to attaching it to the speaker enclosure. Apply a circular bead of silicone adhesive (included) to the inside of the aluminum logo cap, about 1/2-inch (13 mm) from the outer edge.



Align the aluminum logo cap to the desired angle of rotation, and press it onto the back of the enclosure. Apply masking tape (not included) to hold the cap in place until the silicone cures (at least 24 hours).
